Look for the 10¢ Box Tops coupon on hundreds of your favorite products. You can find Box Tops on brands such as Cheerios®, Betty Crocker®, Pillsbury®, Ziploc®, Kleenex®, Hefty® and more! Please cut the coupons as close to the dotted line as possible. And check for expiration dates!

Visit www.boxtops4education.com and register for additional Box Tops credits for the school, get coupons for participating products and check the status of Erie Elementary Box Tops earnings throughout the school year. While on their site you can click the Earn icon to shop the marketplace and earn a percentage for Erie Elementary. It provides a list of participating stores and direct links.



This is a points-based program which allows Erie Elementary to redeem its points to purchase much-needed supplies for the school. Participating products include Campbell's soup products, Franco-American, Peppridge Farm, Swanson, Market Day, V8 Beverages, Prego Pasta sauces.

Just clip the UPC code from the product where you see the Labels for Education logo. Prego and V8 products require submitting the lids.

Clip Project A+ labels (clip entire panel at dotted line) from participating Tyson products. Each label can is worth 24¢.

Turn in juice pouches **of any brand**. They do not have to be cleaned (just empty) and can be put into a bag and dropped off at the same spot as labels for education.



When you purchase participating products with your Club Card from through September 15th, Safeway will donate 10% of the purchase price to Erie Elementary. Coupons must be turned in by October 1st.



Open a Target VISA account and designate Erie Elementary as your school. Target will donate 1% of all purchases made with that card back to Erie Elementary.

You can apply online at www.redcard.target.com or in the store. If you already have a Target Visa but need to designate your school, just call 1-800-316-6142.



When you purchase school supplies at Office Depot, they will credit 5% of your purchase to Erie Elementary in the form of a merchandise card that can be used to purchase supplies for the school.

When making a purchase, simply tell the clerk you want the 5% Back to Schools donation to go to Erie Elementary. They will look up the school in their book and enter the proper code. You can also designate our school when making online purchases.

Computers, technology items, tvs, furniture, ink and toner cartridges and gift cards do not qualify.



Save your plastic grocery sacks and earn money for Erie Elementary School. Walmart will give us \$5.00 for every 60 gallon bag filled with recyclable grocery and shopping bags. No black grocery bags allowed.
